On a Sunday, you knew you would find him listening to a NASCAR race on the radio. Although he didn’t go to church on a regular basis, he loved Gospel music and spent many a Friday night at the Tannehill Opry. At the age of 91, he finally gave his life to Jesus and it was a blessing to see the transformation that God made in his life in his final years. His prayers were simple and genuine. He repeated the scriptures he knew, “The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.” Today, Roy is definitely not in want and he is rejoicing with his Lord, his precious wife, and many loved ones who have gone before him.
