On August 21st, 2016, after a courageous battle, Bernard Busuttill succumbed to

cancer. Bernard was welcomed into his French family in Sfax, Tunisia, on Bastille Day, July 14th, 1936, the first child of the late Sauveur Busuttill and Germaine Muscat Busuttill. He lived in Tunisia, France, and Morocco before settling in the United States in 1975.

Bernard's life-long interest in gastronomy led him to become a respected chef at The Club in Birmingham, Alabama. Bernard was known as a man of warmth, kindness and humor, always charming and delightful company, especially when sharing a passion about a special dish or a fine wine. In retirement he remained active and took great pleasure in playing bridge and volunteering as a mentor for youngsters learning chess.
