Blaine Tyler Marcum, 15, passed away February 15, 2015, at his home in McCalla. He was a freshman in the Finance Academy at Hoover High School and an active member of the youth group at The Station Church. Blaine ran for two years on the Bumpus Cross Country Team and also with the Speed City Summer Track Club.

Whether it was Mark Ingram's setting the record of 1,658 rushing yards in a single season or a vivid recount of Alabama's domination over Miami in the 1992 National Championship game, Blaine could rattle off the statistics about any player, game, or coach associated with the Crimson Tide.

Likewise, Blaine was enthusiastic about movies and could quote from *Grownups* and *Ferris Bueller's Day Off* among countless others. He was especially fond of *The Breakfast Club*. In many ways, Blaine exemplified that movie's humor and message of inclusion. He had the ability to brighten everyone's day and he did it with his infectious laugh.

Blaine is survived by his parents, Brent and Brandi Marcum; sister, Braegan Marcum; grandparents, Marilyn Majerik, Bobby and Patty Marcum; great-grandmother, Margaret Marcum; step-grandmother, Janice Lightsey; aunts, Casey (Keith) Waites, Johni and (J.J.) Mauk; uncles, Torrey (Monica) Marcum, Wesley (Amber) Marcum, and Jonathan (Rachel) Capps; and several cousins. He was preceded in death by his grandfather, Howard Lightsey.

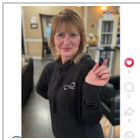

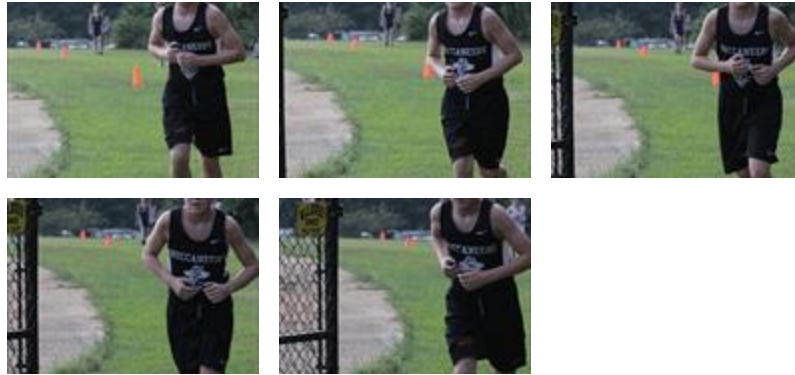
