Diana Taylor Abercrombie, age 79, died in her home in McCalla, AL, on September 19, 2022. Born in Birmingham, AL, she grew up on city sidewalks and in summers, on country roads with family in Marion County, AL. She attended Phillips High School and earned a Bachelor of Arts in Education and a Master of Science in Education from Samford, University. She loved music and instilled love for music in all her children. Having taken piano lessons as a child, she went on to study classical piano in college, taught piano lessons, and developed her signature Gospel improvisational style. A school teacher by profession, she taught at McAdory Elementary School until retirement. With her passion for teaching, she traveled to China twice and taught methods for teaching English to university students. As a student of Bible, she taught Sunday School and facilitated many Bible studies. A devout Christian, she sought to please God, be of service to others, and prayed daily for all her

children and grandchildren. She enjoyed watching Bama football and gathering with her friends in the Red Hat Society and Women's Music Club.

She enjoyed travel whether it was a walk in the woods, a drive through the mountains, or an inter-continental flight. She traveled throughout North America, Europe, the Middle East, and Asia, and on many cruises across many seas. She made annual pilgrimages to Northwest Alabama to honor her Native American, Scottish, and French ancestors. She enjoyed a meal of home cooking just as much as fine dining and was at home both in the country and the city.

Preceded in death by her beloved husband, Robert Mitchell Abercrombie; parents, Carson Lee Taylor and Dimple Palmer Taylor; granddaughter Rachel Edge Peeks, and grandson Jordan Cline Nelson. 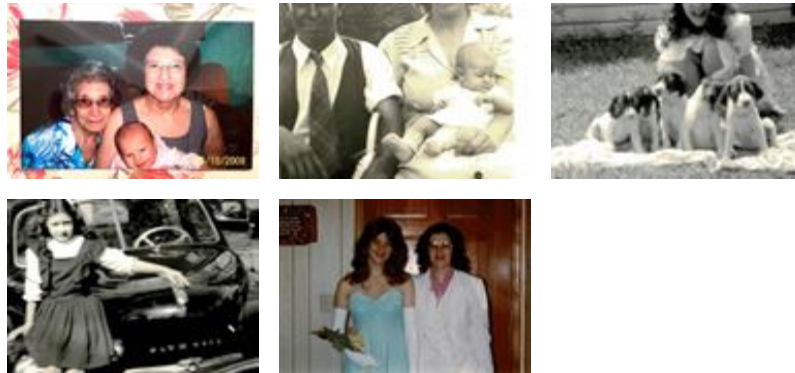

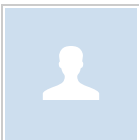
