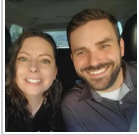

I feel like I got to know the amount of love everyone has for her and that she has for them in such short time. It is very apparent what a beautiful role model she was to the family.

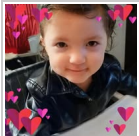
