Rev. Ewell Paul Davis, age 57, passed away on Friday, December 2, 2011. Brother Paul was a 1972 graduate of Tarrant High School and then obtained his undergraduate degree from Livingston University. He received his masters degree from the University of Montevallo and received his masters of divinity from the New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary. He most recently pastored Schultz Creek Baptist Church in Centerville, Alabama. He was also employed as a bus driver at Greenwood Elementary School. He has pastored Eastern Valley Baptist Church, Alexandria Baptist Church, Centralhatchee Baptist Church in Georgia and Calvary Baptist Church in Wedowee. Brother Paul also taught history and coached at Fort Payne High School, Jess Lanier High School, Parrish High School and Oxford High School. He is preceded in death by his brother, Carl "Chris" Davis.
