One of the last conversations she had on this earth was in her sleep when in a clear voice said “Hey Jesus...Let’s go play.” Glenda loved to play, and was always full of energy and vigor, and to say she was strong willed would be an understatement. She and her husband Thomas E. “Bub” Williams raised four children: Tim Williams, Tracy Gullatte, Teri Hartzog, and Butch Williams. A priority was always ensuring that the family’s faith was rock solid, and she made attending her local church, Canaan Baptist a weekly requirement. According to her children, most summer vacations included mission trips with the goal of helping others and sharing their faith. There is no question in anyone’s mind where Glenda is at this moment. Glenda loved sports and the entire family loved to play softball together. According to Tracy, Glenda was doing pop up slides at second base when she was sixty years old. Bub passed in November 2012, and as she yearned for her husband, Glenda’s mind began to slip into Alzheimer’s. Even that disease had a hard time slowing her down. As her memory was slipping, Glenda still had the get-up-and-go to cut five acres of grass with a zero-turn mower and her green thumb was evident to anyone who passed by her home and lawn. At 82 she still walked a mile a day up until the last several weeks of her life.
