



Holley G. McDonald Jr.

February 15, 1944 - December 29, 2017

Holley Grant McDonald Jr was born February 15, 1944, to Holley and Bernice Baker McDonald and was raised in the Carbon Hill area of Fayette County Alabama. He was a 1962 graduate of Hubbertville High School in Fayette County and joined the Marine Corps that same year at age 18. He was a Vietnam Veteran and retired from Marine Corps on August 31, 1966, due to injury received in combat. He received the Purple Heart and a multitude of other honors. He graduated from the University of Alabama and became a Certified Public Accountant. He was a partner at Mackle, Splawn, Tindall and McDonald and Carl, Riggs and Ingram. After retiring he became a consultant for Pearce, Bevill, Leesburg and Moore. He worked every day until the day he became ill. He passed away in the comfort of his home December 29, 2017. He is survived by his wife, Neata Perry McDonald of fifty years, three children: Christa McDonald Rummage (Robert), Carlos Grant McDonald (Leslie), Holly McDonald Andrews (Kevin), seven grandchildren: Romen McDonald (Keri), Candis Olive Hancock (Taylor), Hayden McDonald, Hallie McDonald, Hardy McDonald, Dylan Andrews, Zoey Andrews and three great children Kolee McDonald, Cruise McDonald and Sailor McDonald. He is also survived by his sister Sharon Herren (Jerry) and brother Danny McDonald and a host of nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother Rudy McDonald.

Grant was a loving husband, father and grandfather. He was an honorable man who enjoyed his family, friends, work and fishing.
