Jane Goode Hubbard, 71, originally of Valdese, NC passed away peacefully on September 26. Born March 4, 1941, to Thomas Frank Goode and Dorothy Morgan Goode, Jane graduated from Valdese High School in 1959 where she was Editor of the yearbook. Jane went on to attend the Women's College in Greensboro (now UNCG).
