



Joel Douglas Foshee

April 13, 1948 - July 7, 2017

Joel Foshee, of Dadeville, AL, took his last breath on July 7th at 6:03 PM. He was surrounded by close friends and family in his last days, at Princeton Baptist Hospital, close to his beloved childhood home of Ensley, after a long battle with pancreatic cancer. He played baseball at Samford University, where he was a proud member of Pi Kappa Phi, before graduating and completing his graduate studies at the University of Montevallo. Joel was proud to have coached football and baseball at Pittman Jr High, Tarrant High School, St. Clair County High School, Fort Payne, Pelham, and at McGill-Toolen in Mobile. Among the wealthiest people alive - in friendship, Joel will be remembered for forging long lasting friendships with childhood friends, clients, fellow golfers, former players and anyone fortunate to engage him in conversation once. He is survived by his two sons Brent and Brandon, daughter-in-law Tammi, granddaughter Kendall, younger brother and oldest friend Jimmy Foshee, sister-in-law Ramona, niece Kimberly, and nephew Tod. During the eighteen months he underwent chemotherapy he routinely drove long distances to see his clients because he preferred to do business in person, maintained his under par golf game, and spent as much time with his granddaughter as he could muster. He was a lifelong Alabamian who was proud of his roots in the state, his family, Alabama football, his service in the Marine Corps, and most importantly his faith. As he left his friends and loved ones on Earth he joined his friends and family in Heaven, and with that knowledge those of us he left behind will endeavor to persevere with his

memories strong in our hearts. Joel asked that mourners be given the choice of flowers or a donation to St. Jude Children's Hospital in his name. The viewing will be held from 6-8 pm at Lakeside Baptist Church in Birmingham on Monday, July 10th along with the funeral service at 1 pm the following day. Interment will be at Helena City Cemetery, Helena, AL.
