Joseph Dale Oglesby “Joe”, 78, of Bessemer, AL received his heavenly promotion on May 4, 2024. Joe succumbed to a brief battle with cancer at his home, surrounded by family and a few close friends.

Joe graduated from Bessemer High School in 1963. He proudly served in the United States Army Reserves for 6 years.

Joe worked as an Insurance Claims Specialist throughout his career and also later served in a role as legal liaison for the company in cases ranging from medical malpractice to various types of workplace discrimination/harassment; he retired from Traveler’s Insurance Company in 2006. After retirement, Joe enjoyed spending time with family and friends.

Having a great sense of humor, Joe loved to laugh and to bring joy to those around him.
