September 2, 1975 - November 6, 2024

Lori Elizabeth Wilson Sills passed away from a brief, but critical illness, Wednesday, November 6, 2024. Her loss was completely unexpected, and the family is profoundly saddened.

Lori was born on September 2, 1975 in Louisville, Kentucky to Libby (deceased) and Chuck Wilson. Lori is survived by her husband, Kirk Sills, father, Chuck, and sister Joni Marie Lackey (Todd) and her three (3) dogs, Georgia, Nixon & Piper. She grew up in Louisville, KY; Columbia, S.C.; and Lilburn, Georgia where she attended Parkview High School. She graduated from Georgia Southern University with an undergraduate degree in Community Health and masters degree in Health Care Management Phoenix University. While attending Georgia Southern she met the love of her life, Kirk Sills, whom she later married, November 6, 1999. While at Georgia Southern, she worked at Walker Pharmacy and Gifts and it was there she found her medical calling. She and Kirk moved to Birmingham, Alabama where Lori

Lori loved her work family and family alike and was happiest among them at her favorite

spot in the world – the beach. There were few things she loved more than being surrounded

by her family, listening to country music, watching Alabama football (and Georgia) being

with her fur babies, or chatting on the phone. She was her husband's north star and

lighthouse, along with her canine kids Georgia, Piper and Nixon. She was her nieces' and

nephews' favorite aunt, was closely bonded with her sister, Joni, and loved her sisters in

law and brothers in law forming a special bond with them all, especially Lisa Sills.

There are few people like Lori in the world today. If you knew or spent time around Lori, you

knew with her you were in the judgment-free zone; she would always lend a listening ear or

a shoulder to cry on—you could tell her anything and everything without fear of judgment.

Her laugh was joyous and infectious to those around her. She never met anyone that she

didn't like and had the uncanny ability to remember everybody's name she met. Her

magnetic personality was only matched by her beautiful, exotic eyes and her incredibly

huge heart. Lori had this ability to make you feel important, and, to her, you actually were.

Her compassionate altruism extended to anybody and everybody who had the

fortune to know her. She was the glue of her family and always knew exactly what to say in every situation. The only things Lori didn't like were clowns and frogs, or Santa Claus.

No doubt her fur babies that went before her - Bud, Buster, Bubba, and Jack - were there to greet her at those pearly gates alongside her mom, Libby, and father-in-law, Daddy Carl.

Words can't quite capture the impact she had on the lives she touched along the way. The outpouring of love from friends and family during her brief hospital stay was a testament to

how loved and cherished she was, is, and always will be. She leaves an indescribable void

but has given us a heart full of love. She will forever be remembered for the unforgettable way she made you feel.

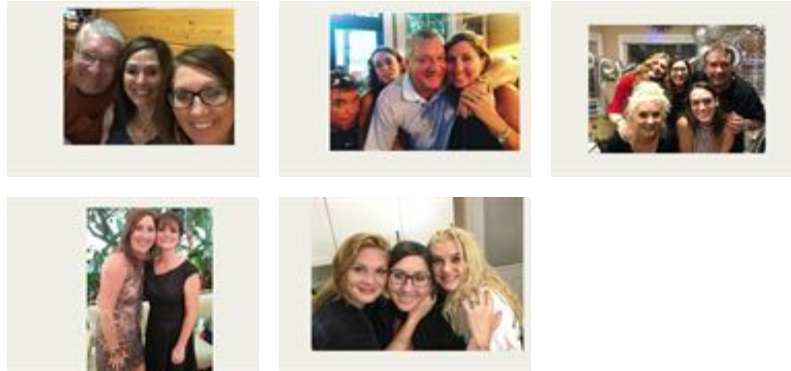

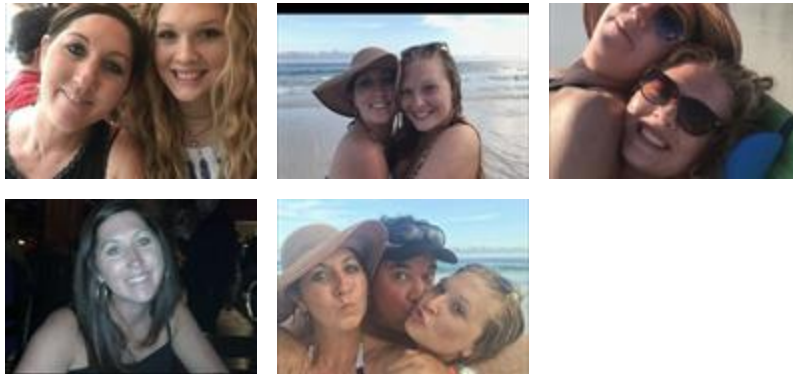
