Baptist Church as his health allowed. He had countless friends, told endless jokes, and was loved by all.

Neil enjoyed his life to the fullest and til the end. Even in a wheelchair, he found a way to always have a positive attitude. He had such a great personality and a very kind heart. He will be greatly missed by the ones who loved him most.
