Samuel Wayne Tibbs, age 68, of McCalla, passed away on Saturday, April 4, 2015. Mr. Tibbs was retired from the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department with 39 years of service. 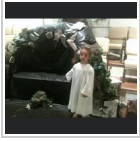
