Sharon Bush White, age 76 of McCalla, passed away on Wednesday, April 12, 2023. She was born on January 8, 1947 to the late Robert and Lois Bush in Bessemer, Alabama. Sharon graduated from McAdory High School in 1965. She was married to her husband, Johnny White from 1964 until her death. Johnny and Sharon lived in the Bessemer area all of their lives.

She was a dedicated wife and mother, who served as a homemaker before going to work at Bessemer Utilities in 1979. She worked there for several years before going to work for her husband at their business in Hueytown, Brown Heating and Cooling. They owned their business from 1984 to 2015. She was an active member of Flint Hill Baptist Church for over 50 years. At the time of her death, she and Johnny were attending The Baptist Church at McAdory.

She was preceded in death by her parents along with her siblings, Wanda Bush Merriam (Roger), and Terry Bush (Karen). She is survived by her husband of 59 years: Johnny White; her daughter, Kimberly White Robinson; her son, Jamie White (Tina); and her grandchild, Bradley W. Robinson.

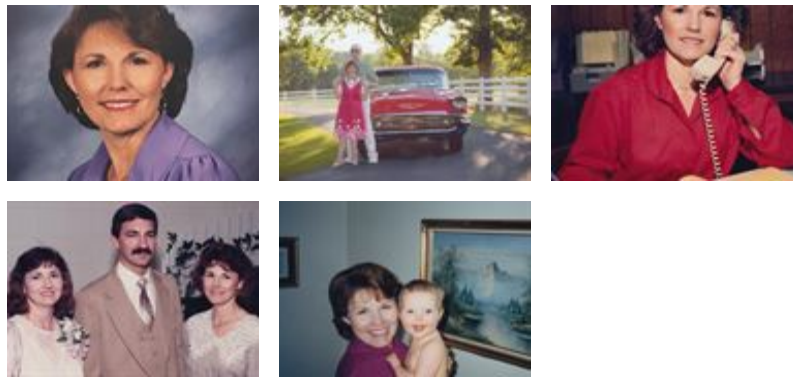
