Wallace worked for the U.S. Department of Labor, Wage and Hour Division for 29 years. He began as a Compliance Officer. The last fifteen years of his government service, he was a District Director of offices in Memphis, TN; Denver, CO; and Fort Lauderdale, FL. When he retired in 1993, he was the District Director for the State of Alabama. On his retirement he was awarded the Distinguished Service Award, the Meritorious Achievement Award, and several outstanding performance awards.

He was a dedicated Boy Scout volunteer, serving in various positions for 20 years. He still enjoys the contacts with the young men he once knew as boys.
