William Carl Hall of Bessemer, Alabama, passed away on Saturday, May 9. Carl was born in New Hope, Alabama, on July 31, 1937, to Evelyn Kirkland Hall and James

“Jim Ed” Hall. He was preceded in death by his parents and by his older brother, James C. Hall.

He is survived by his loving wife of 47 years, Christie B. Hall, and many dear friends.

During World War II, Carl’s family moved to Birmingham, Alabama, where he discovered a

love of motorcycles in his youth. That passion led to a job repairing and painting

motorcycles and sparked a lifelong love of working with his hands and restoring things.

Carl proudly served his country in the Naval Reserve and retired from Buffalo Rock

Company following a successful career in sales. He loved playing golf, fishing, and

traveling. He and his wife often returned to his childhood home in North Alabama to fish on

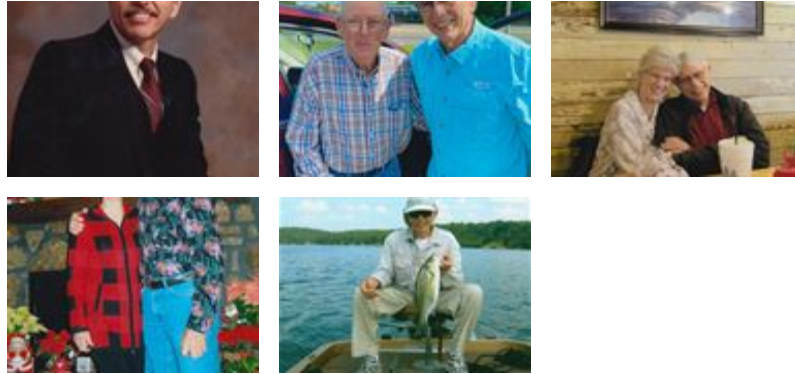
